Southern Yellow Pine timber (not to be confused with Quebec Yellow) comes from southern is imported in most standard thicknesses, generally, boards are 4", 6", 8", 10" and 12" wide and Environment not listed in CITES. Available from well-managed sources. HARDWOODS AND HIGH QUALITY SOFTWOODS states of USA. It is a relatively 'heavy' weight softwood, used for joinery products such as stairs. It lengths 8' - 16'. It is imported kiln dried and thin stock is usually graded 'Saps' due to the clearerest grade sapwood being preferred, with thicker boards imported in 'prime & better' grade.

Latin name Pinus Palustris & Pinus Elliottii

Also known as Yellow Pine, Southern Pine. Has similarities with Pitch Pine.

Environment not listed in CITIES. Available from well-managed sources.

Drying Supplied as Kiln dried, typically 8%-12% m.c

Southern: Yellow Pine Properties

Strength: Similar to Douglas Fir

Working Qualities: Not suitable for bending due to resin content. Moderate resistance to cutting edges. Resin may clog saw teeth and cutters.

Durability: Moderately durable, Sapwood is permeable for preservatives, resin similarity to Pitch Pine.

Moisture Movement: Medium

Texture: May have coarse texture.
